- Listen to official evacuation instructions to make your decision. There may be a direction you need to go to avoid further danger.
- **Leave written messages with marker, chalk, or paint in large obvious locations** (near front door, in drive way)!
- Communicate your status: Safe or Need Help, Evacuating to [location] via [route].
- If you must leave to a location other than a pre-planned one, leave complete details.
- Communicate how many and who is with you, and who is not and where they are or should be.

**Grab essentials, family documents fire box, and the Emergency Grab and Go box before you leave!**

**Monitor Emergency Communications on TV, Radio, Weather Radio, Scanner or CB radio.**
